OUR JOURNEY

2016

In June 2016, a team of volunteers and partners formed to bring our mission of hope and healing to life. The Baptist Immigration Center generously offered the use of their building.

2019

In September 2019, we relocated to our dedicated clinic space in McKinney. Our current home allowed for increased operating hours to serve more patients.



We purchased 2750 Virginia Parkway for our new clinic home to open mid-2026.

2017-18

In July 2017, CommonGood Medical, formerly the Hope Clinic of McKinney, began operations one day a week, providing medical services regardless of a patient's ability to pay.

In 2018, clinic operations expanded to two days a week.

The Patient Assistance Program was established to assist established patients with medical needs outside our walls. In 2025, over \$108,000 was spent for patients to receive services from our CommonGood Network partners.

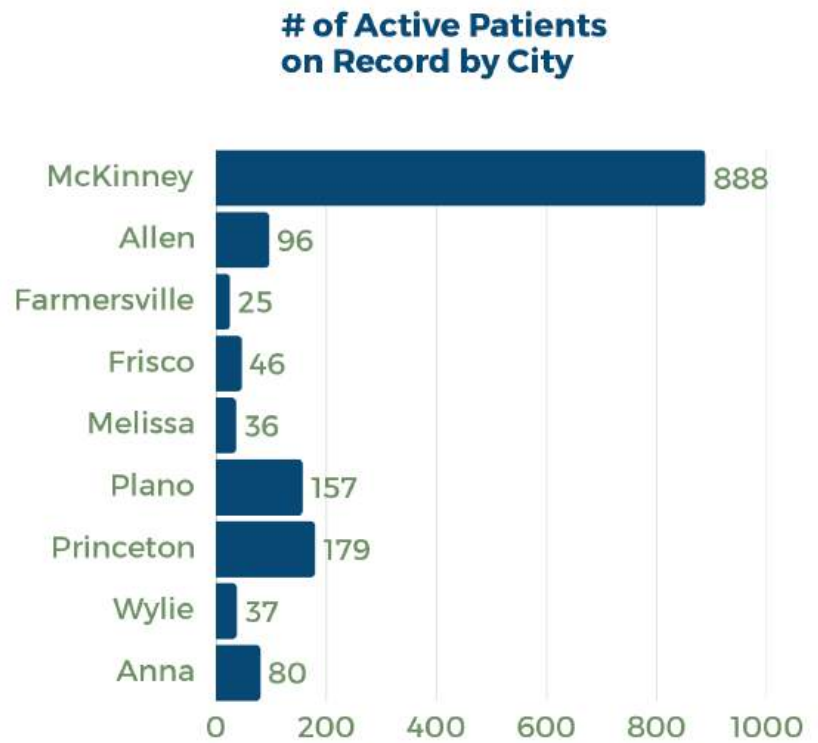
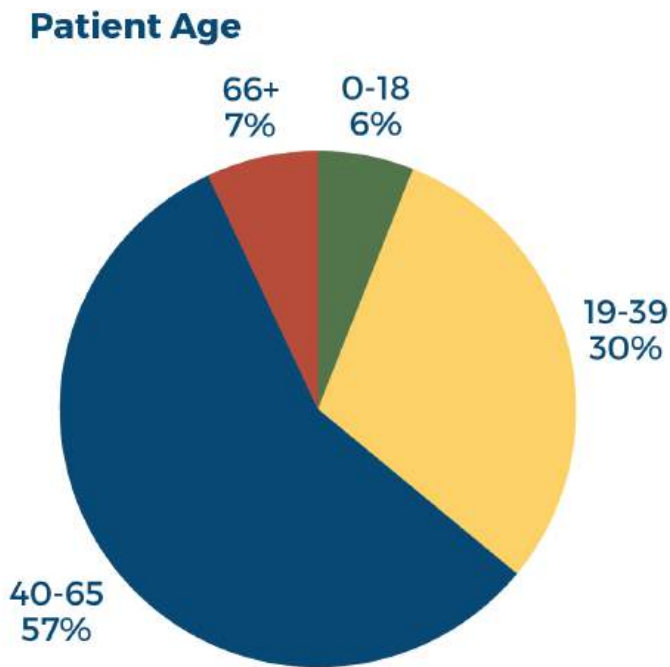
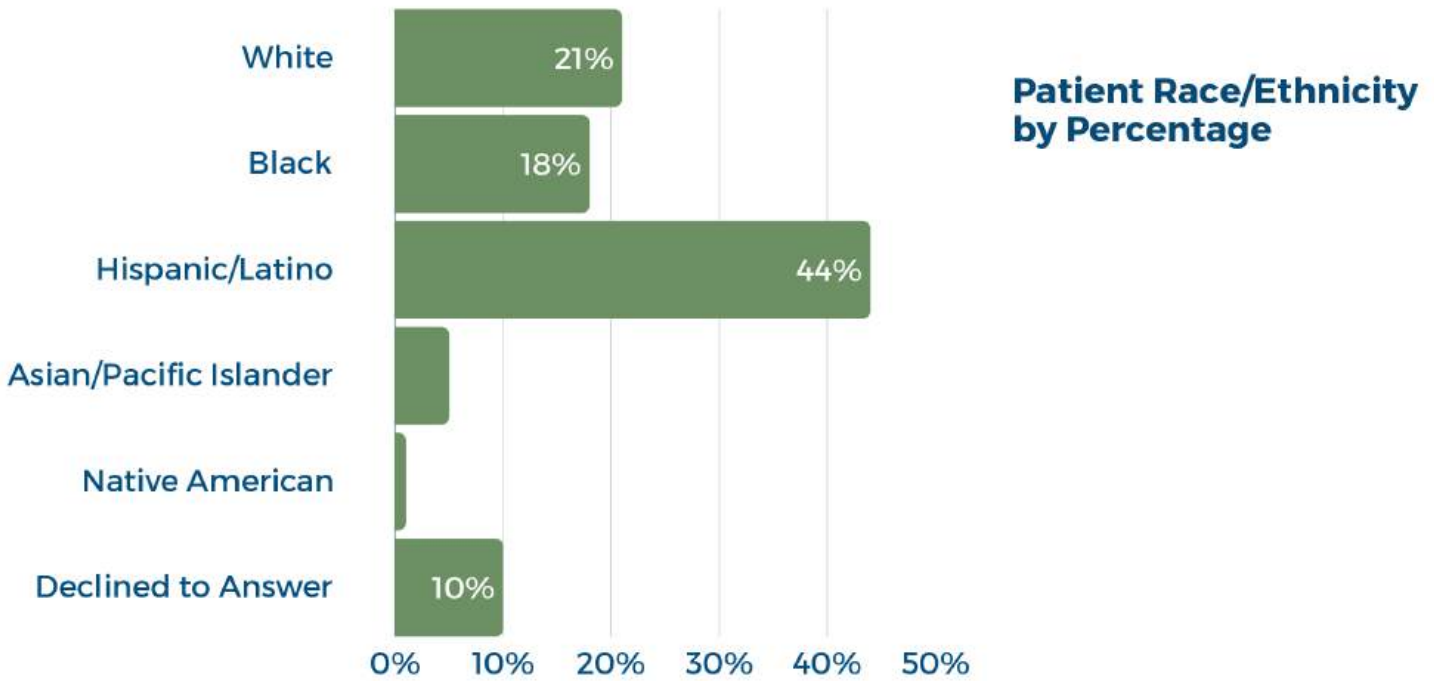
The CommonGood Network continued to serve our patients with much needed specialty care and surgeries by expanding to 40 providers, 2 pharmacies, and 2 dentists.

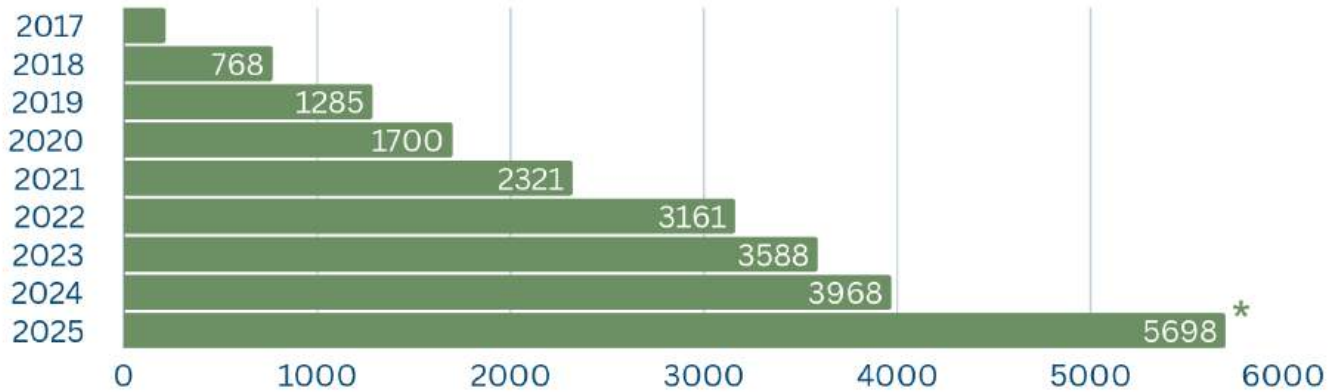

Our Growth 2017 - 2025

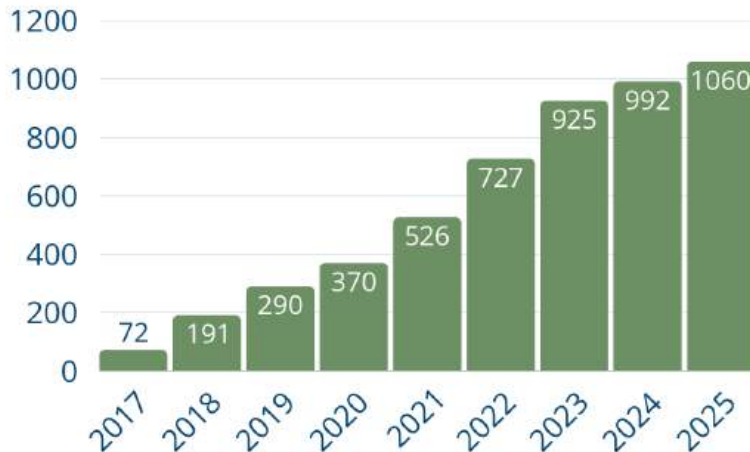


Patient Appointments

Patient Stories

Rebecca is 32 years old with three children. She lives with a chronic skin condition that is treatable but not curable. Recently, her skin condition has worsened after a domestic abuse situation, which forced her to move out of her home and in with her parents. Now, crippled by fear, Rebecca only feels safe leaving the house with a family member escorting her. Visiting CommonGood Medical's clinic has been one of the very few places she is willing to go. While the provision of comprehensive medical care, including dermatology, has been helpful for her physical health, Rebecca's access to CommonGood Medical's counselor and mental health resources have given her hope for her future.



David is 28 years old and a college grad. He suffers from depression, anxiety, and alcohol abuse. His mental health symptoms started early in his teens following a friend's death. The alcohol addiction came later as he tried to cope with his depression and grew over time to something he could no longer control. Now, after attending rehab, he has started over once again as a retail store manager. His colleagues, team, and customers respect and appreciate him, and as a result, the store's bottom line has thrived with him at the helm. This success, however, does not change the fact that, like so many other hardworking individuals, David's job does not offer medical insurance, and he cannot afford it on the open market. Through CommonGood Medical, he has been able to access essential primary care as well as mental health services that would not be attainable otherwise. Nonetheless, David donates to his care at every visit.

2025 marked the launch of our Gap Year program. **Pulse and Purpose** is a medical internship rooted in faith, service, and hands-on care. This medical internship is a partnership between CommonGood Medical and Watermark Health in Dallas, offering real clinical exposure, purpose-driven service, and meaningful community impact for students pursuing a career in the medical field.

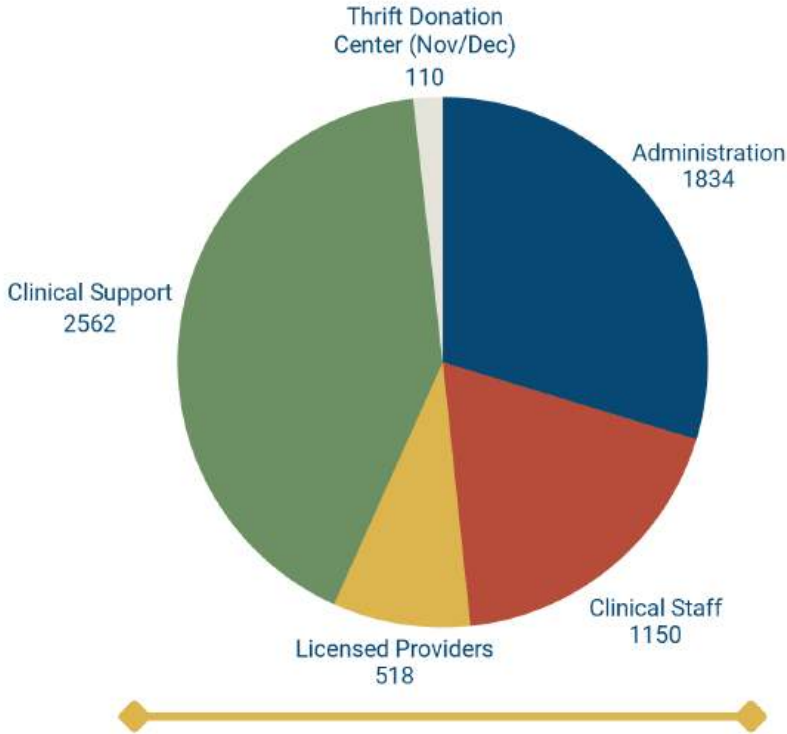

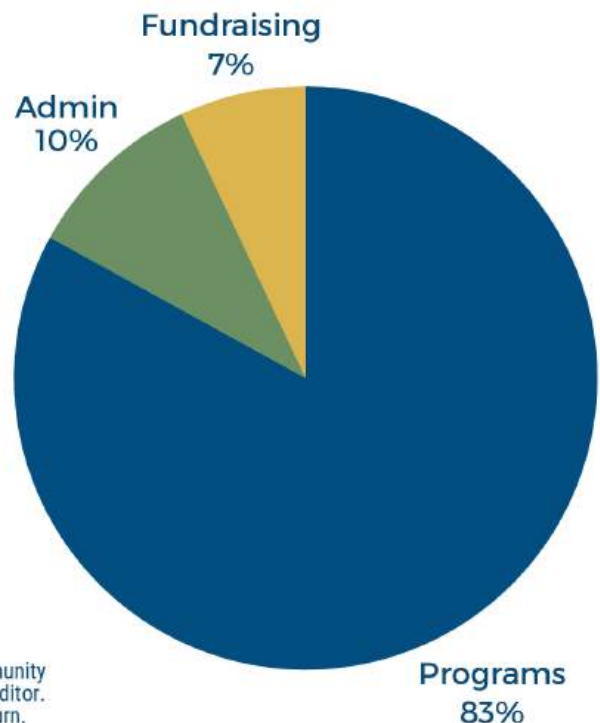

In 2025, we launched a \$3.75 million capital campaign to purchase, equip, and operate a new clinic in McKinney. 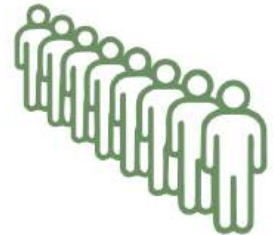
To date, we have raised \$2.71M toward our goal.

Hello CommonGood Family,

As we close the door on another year, I am thankful for all that has transpired in 2025. We kicked off the year by opening our second location in rural Farmersville, expanding access to one of the most underserved regions in Collin County.

When we realized in the early spring that we had reached our capacity for growth at our current location, you paved the way for the next stage by helping us raise over \$3 million of our \$3.88 million capital campaign to purchase and renovate a building. After the renovation is complete, our new space will dramatically expand our ability to offer primary and specialty medical services.

And even more important than growth, God has used you and your support to bring meaningful and lasting impacts in our community.

Unfortunately, in many ways, American medicine has become more about personal or corporate financial gain than patient benefit. Our shared calling is to fight that trend with the belief that our patients are image bearers of God - worthy of love, dignity, and respect.

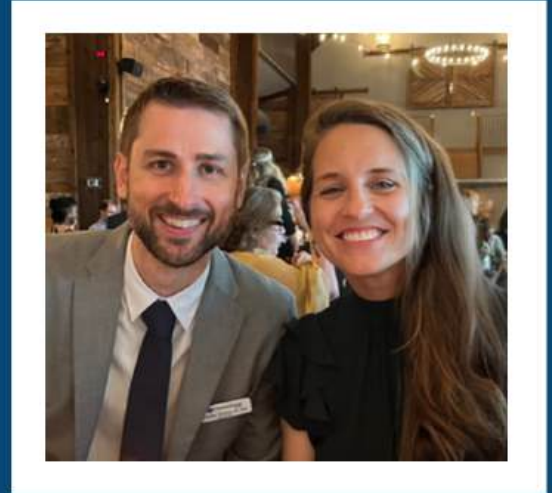
To our many partners, volunteers, and supporters, we are deeply grateful for the role you play. Loving our neighbors through medicine cannot be accomplished single-handedly.

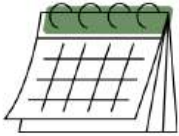
